Legislative Executive Board to Meet

PIERRE – The Executive Board for the SD Legislature will hold its second meeting of the 2018 interim on Monday, April 23, 2018, in Pierre. The meeting will be held in room 413 of the State Capitol starting at 1:30 PM CDT.

The April meeting will include finalizing interim study committee assignments, selecting Issue Memorandum topics, hearing funding requests for Lean Projects, discussion on the Program Evaluation process and topics, and discussion on initiated measures and constitutional amendment hearings.
