GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS AND AUDIT COMMITTEE TO MEET

PIERRE – The Legislature’s Government Operations and Audit Committee will hold the second meeting of the 2019 interim on May 23, 2019. The meeting will begin at 8:00 a.m. (CT) in Room 362 of the State Capitol in Pierre, South Dakota.

The Government Operations and Audit Committee, Chaired by Senator Ryan Maher (R-Isabel) and Vice Chair Representative Sue Peterson (R-Sioux Falls), will review corrective action plans for audit findings included in the State of South Dakota Single Audit Report for fiscal year 2018 for the Department of Revenue and the Department of Social Services. The Department of Tourism and the Department of Education will discuss performance management indicators. The Department of Agriculture will discuss the pesticide regulatory program.
