## LEGISLATIVE EXECUTIVE BOARD TO MEET

**PIERRE** – The Executive Board for the SD Legislature will hold its fourth meeting of the 2019 interim on Monday, June 10, 2019, in Sioux Falls. The meeting will be held in the offices of the South Dakota Investment Council, 4009 West 49th Street, Suite 300.

The June meeting includes selecting a new member to fill the upcoming vacancies on the State Investment Council and the Code Commission and selecting two members to fill vacancies on the Commission on Uniform Legislation. The Executive Board will also be hiring the new Code Counsel and determining the scope of two program evaluations. The meeting is scheduled to begin at 1:15 p.m. (CT) and is open to the public, except for the two scheduled executive sessions to discuss personnel matters.
