Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations to Meet

PIERRE –The Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations will hold their third meeting of the 2019 interim on Tuesday, August 20, 2019. The meeting will begin at 11:00 a.m. (CT) in the Jensen-Smith Board Room of the South Dakota State University Alumni Association in Brookings, South Dakota.

The Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations, co-chaired by Senator John Wiik (R-Big Stone City) and Representative Chris Karr (R-Sioux Falls), will review revisions to the Letter of Intent relating to University Center operations that were voted on during the July meeting and will consider a new Letter of Intent requiring annual financial reporting on University Center operations. The committee will also discuss locations for the interim west river tour to be held in November.
