### **Offenses Regarding Controlled Substances Interim Study Committee to Meet**

**PIERRE** – The Offenses Regarding Controlled Substances Interim Study Committee will hold its fourth meeting of the interim on Friday, November 1, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. (CT) in Room 414 of the State Capitol in Pierre with an additional Digital Dakota Network location in Courtroom 1B of the Minnehaha County Courthouse in Sioux Falls.

Discussion will include an information update on questions asked during the October 22, 2019 meeting, and possible recommendations on legislative action from committee members.
