LEGISLATIVE EXECUTIVE BOARD AND BONDING COMMITTEE TO MEET

PIERRE – The Executive Board for the SD Legislature will hold its sixth meeting of the 2019 Interim on Monday, November 18 and Tuesday, November 19, 2019, in Pierre. The meeting will be held in Room 413 of the State Capitol starting at 10:00 a.m. (CT) on Monday and 8:00 a.m. (CT) on Tuesday.

The November meeting will include hearing interim committee final reports, the Investment Council report, the judicial opinions report, and the program evaluation reports. The Board will also review issue memos for approval, be updated on the Legislative Intern process, and consider proposing legislative rule changes. The full agenda for the meeting will be available on the Legislative Research Council's website at sdlegislature.gov. The meeting is open to the public.

The Executive Board also serves as the Bonding Committee and will hear Bonding Committee reports immediately following adjournment of the Executive Board meeting on Tuesday (approximately 11:00 a.m.). The Bonding Committee hears and acts on reports from the SD Housing Development Authority; SD Conservancy District; SD Value Added Finance Authority; SD Economic Development Finance Authority; SD Building Authority; and SD Health and Educational Facilities Authority.
