GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS AND AUDIT COMMITTEE TO MEET

Pierre - The Legislature's Government Operations and Audit Committee will hold the fourth meeting of the 2014 interim on July 29, 2014, in Pierre. The meeting will begin at 9:00 a.m. in Room 413 of the State Capitol.

The Government Operations and Audit Committee, chaired by Senator Larry Tidemann (R-Brookings) and vice-chair Representative Dan Dryden (R-Rapid City), will receive an update on corrective actions relating to the Governor's Office of Economic Development (GOED) audit, agreed-upon procedures engagement and the internal control review discussed at the March 7, 2014 Committee meeting. In addition, the GOED will discuss the outcomes from the calendar years 2012 and 2013 Futures Fund grants. The Building South Dakota Fund annual reports will be presented by the GOED, South Dakota Housing Development Authority, and the South Dakota Department of Education. The Oversight Council will provide information regarding the annual report called for in the Public Safety Improvement Act. The Department of Health will review corrective action plans for fiscal year 2013 Single Audit findings. In addition, the Committee will propose solutions to correct the deficit in the Law Enforcement Officers Training Fund. The meeting is open to the public.

In addition to Chair Senator Tidemann and Vice-Chair Representative Dryden, committee members include, Senators Jean Hunhoff (R-Yankton), Blake Curd (R-Sioux Falls), Phyllis Heineman (R-Sioux Falls), and Larry Lucas (D-Mission); and Representatives Justin Cronin (R-Gettysburg), Melissa Magstadt (R-Watertown), Mark Mickelson (R-Sioux Falls), and Susan Wismer (D-Britton).
