### GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS AND AUDIT COMMITTEE TO MEET

**Pierre** - The Legislature's Government Operations and Audit Committee will hold the sixth meeting of the 2014 interim on November 13, 2014, in Pierre. The meeting will begin at 9:00 a.m. in Room 413 of the State Capitol.

The Government Operations and Audit Committee, chaired by Senator Larry Tidemann (R-Brookings) and vice-chair Representative Dan Dryden (R-Rapid City), will review the 2014 annual report from the State 911 Coordinator. The Committee will discuss the use of performance measures with the Department of Health. The Department of Agriculture will provide follow-up information on food safety measures for unpasteurized dairy products and the results of the Department's meetings with producers. The Department of Social Services will update the Committee on the Medicaid management information system project. The Board of Regents will discuss changes made to the contract authorization process. The Committee will review written responses to Committee questions about the EB-5 program from Joop Bollen, President of SDRC, Inc. The meeting is open to the public.
