Jolene's Law Task Force to Meet

PIERRE - Jolene's Law Task Force will meet Tuesday, October 14, 2014, in LCR 1 & 2 on the third floor of the State Capitol, at 10:00 a.m. (CDT). The task force will hear different perspectives on child abuse, including testimony from a mother of sexually abused children, and presentations from the Beadle County State's Attorney, an FBI victim advocate, and the Oglala Sioux Tribe Attorney General.
