RETIREMENT LAWS COMMITTEE TO MEET

The interim Retirement Laws Committee, chaired by Senator Bruce Rampelberg (R-Rapid City), will meet jointly with the South Dakota Retirement System Board of Trustees on Wednesday, September 2, 2015, at 9:30 a.m. at the SD Investment Office, 4009 West 49th St., Suite 300 in Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

The committee will receive updates from the South Dakota Retirement System on the fiscal year 2015 financial status, potential 2016 legislation, return to work provisions, and supplemental retirement and special pay plans. The committee will also hear a presentation regarding plan design changes for new members of the South Dakota Retirement System.
