### RIVER BASIN NATURAL RESOURCE DISTRICT OVERSIGHT ADVISORY TASK FORCE TO MEET

**PIERRE** – The River Basin Natural Resource District Oversight Advisory Task Force will meet on Tuesday, September 20, 2016, in Room 413 of the Capitol in Pierre. The meeting will begin at 10:00 a.m. The public is invited to attend.

Legislation was passed by the 2015 Legislature to provide for the creation of the River Basin Natural Resource Districts. This task force was tasked with the responsibility of overseeing the implementation of these districts.
