SD High School Activities Association Interim Committee to Meet

Pierre - The SD High School Activities Association Interim Committee will hold its second meeting on Thursday, August 20, 2015, in room 412 of the State Capitol in Pierre. The Executive Board for the SD Legislature selected the SD High School Activities Association as one of the 2015 Interim Study Committees, and the committee's first meeting was June 26, 2015. Chair for the committee is Senator Craig Tieszen (R-Rapid City), and Vice Chair is Representative Jim Bolin (R-Canton).

The second meeting will include a presentation on the legal precedent currently surrounding transgender protections around the country, and presentations by the SDHSAA on their own transgender policy and site selection policy. The meeting is scheduled to begin at 10:00 AM (CDT) and is open to the public.
