Tribal Economic Development Task Force to Meet

The Tribal Economic Development Task Force will meet Friday, June 5, 2015, in the Oahe Room at the Grand River Casino just west of Mobridge, South Dakota, from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. (central time). The Task Force was created by House Bill 1213 during the 2014 Legislative Session to provide a more accessible forum for Tribal Leaders from each of the nine sovereign Tribes to meet with Legislators and discuss how best to address economic development across the state.

The Task Force is chaired by Representative Don Haggar (Sioux Falls), and the second meeting will include presentations from the Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe, the Sisseton-Wahpeton Oyate, and the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe.
