<b>1-19-2017</b>	<b>Department of Education: Board of Education</b> Amend rules to update the state certification process for educators to: streamline the certification process; eliminate unnecessary barriers to the certification process; and ensure educators meet the minimum content and pedagogical knowledge requirements expected of them prior to being certified; 43 SDR 95, January 3, 2017.
<b>1-26-2017 (Originally set for 12-16-2017)</b>	<b>Department of Transportation</b> Amend a Tripp County speed zone rule by reducing a speed limit from 65 mph to 45 mph on U.S. Highway 183 beginning at its junction with U.S. Highway 18 in Colome, then south for 0.5 mile; 43 SDR 85, November 28, 2016.
<b>1-26-2017</b>	<b>Department of Transportation</b> Amend a 65 mile per hour speed zone on Interstate 29 by extending it an additional 1.58 miles south to begin at milepost 72.72 and end at milepost 85.25; 43 SDR 93, December 27, 2016.
