**Notice of Proposed Rules:** (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed with the Legislative Research Council.)

**Department of Transportation:** (April 3, 2018) intends to amend rules to make speed limit changes on State Trunk Highway 50 in and around Tyndall and Tabor. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the agency, is SDCL § 32-25-7.

**Department of Environment and Natural Resources: Board of Water Management:** (April 5, 2018) intends to amend rules to update references; correct typographical errors; require additional testing requirements for certain tank components; clarify training requirements; require additional reporting requirements;

extend regulatory compliance to field constructed tanks and airport hydrant tanks; place additional requirements on certain classes of emergency generator tanks; and eliminate the usage of ball float valves for overflow protection. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the agency, is SDCL §§ 34A-2-93 and 34A-2-99.

A public hearing will be held in the Floyd Matthew Training Center, Joe Foss Building, 523 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on May 2, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. CT.
