Department of Labor and Regulation:
Appraiser Certification Program: (June 6, 2016) intends to amend rules to allow appraisers to submit appraisals for compliance review midway through the experience hours required to upgrade to a higher level of licensure or certification; add midway review upgrade fees; establish allegation of non-compliance as the first step for initiation of an investigation and prior to formal complaint charges; and replace the term anonymous complaint with allegation of non-compliance. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL §§ 36-21B-3 and 36-21B-4.

The rules provide additional guidance on the administration of drugs for the control of behavior and for sedation as prescribed by a licensed medical professional, on time alone, on prohibition of time out rooms, on the use of person centered planning in the individualized service plan, on the role and responsibilities of a case manager, and on the use of advisory boards by entities that are organized outside of the state of South Dakota.
