### FILINGS IN THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COUNCIL'S OFFICE:

**Notice of Proposed Rules:** (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

**Department of Revenue: SD Commission on Gaming:** (October 24, 2016) is proposing to amend Gaming rules to add pay tables to the existing blackjack game of 21+3; add a variation to the game of blackjack known as Bust Bonus; clarify that wagers may not exceed posted table bet limits for the play – Let it ride and let it ride bonus including three card bonus optional side bet or progressive optional side bet; add a rule to provide for a variation of the play of poker known as High Card Flush; provide that closed circuit surveillance of slot machines is required for machines that have awards of \$12,000 or greater; and require at least one video recorder within licensee surveillance systems. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the commission, is SDCL §§ 42-7B-4 and 42-7B-7.

A public hearing will be held in City Hall, 102 Sherman Street, Deadwood, South Dakota, on November 17, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to the

South Dakota Commission on Gaming, 445 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Materials sent by mail must reach the Commission on Gaming by November 15, 2016, to be considered. However, the Commission requests that all written comments be received by November 11, 2016, to allow for adequate consideration prior to the hearing. ### REMINDER OF HEARINGS SCHEDULED

<b>11-3-2016</b>	<b>Department of Game, Fish, and Parks</b> Amend a Uses of Parks and Public Lands rule to allow for removal of shed antlers from state-owned lands; amend Spring Wild Turkey Hunting Season rules to set the number and types of licenses available for the Prairie Units, make adjustments to the Black Hill and Unit 49A (Meade County) unit boundaries as outlined in the South Dakota Wild Turkey Management Plan, 2016-2020, set the number of archery turkey access permits for Adams Homestead and Nature Preserve, and remove the language in rule depicting the

	license type and number of licenses from each hunting unit; amend Fishing Seasons and Methods rules to allow anglers to keep a legally caught possession limit of fish while on the ice, allow anglers to clean fish species, while on the ice, that do not have water-specific size restrictions, and require that fish possessed on the ice adhere to the transportation rule that requires fish to be readily countable; and amend Aquatic Invasive Species rules to add Red Swamp Crayfish to the list of invertebrate aquatic invasive species, allow for the transport of aquatic invasive species by an employee of a business that has been approved by the department to transport a boat or motorboat to a facility for the purpose of aquatic invasive species removal, and allow a person who has been authorized by the department to transport their own watercraft to a department-approved facility for immediate decontamination, remove the exception in rule that allows all drain plugs, bailers or valves in trailered boats to be closed or remain in place during transport from a boat ramp parking area to an immediately-adjacent fish cleaning station, and remove the exception in rule that allows fish or aquatic bait to be transported in water obtained from a lake, river, or stream from a boat ramp parking area to an immediately-adjacent fish cleaning station; 43 SDR 65, October 17, 2016.
<b>11-4-2016</b>	<b>Department of Labor and Regulation: Board of Technical Professions</b> Amend a rule to add deadlines for national examinations that will be moved to computer based testing (CBT); 43 SDR 65, October 17, 2016.
<b>11-15-2016</b>	<b>Department of Education: Board of Education</b> Amend a Share Services Grants rule to make it clear that individual school districts will be reimbursed for expenses in order to ensure accurate accounting documentation of grant funds; 43 SDR 65, October 17, 2016.
<b>11-17-2016</b>	<b>Department of Revenue: SD Commission on Gaming</b> Amend Gaming rules to add pay tables to the existing blackjack game of 21+3; add a variation to the game of blackjack known as Bust Bonus; clarify that wagers may not exceed posted table bet limits for the play – Let it ride and let it ride bonus including three card bonus optional side bet or progressive optional side bet; add a rule to provide for a variation of the play of poker known as High Card Flush; provide that closed circuit surveillance of slot machines is required for machines that have awards of \$12,000 or greater; and require at least one video recorder within licensee surveillance systems; 43 SDR 71, October 31, 2016.
