**Notice of Proposed Rules:** (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed with the Legislative Research Council.)

#### *Department of Transportation:*

(November 5, 2018) intends to amend rules to reduce from 55 to 35 miles per hour the limited speed zone on Highway 12 in and around Summit, and lower from 65 to 55 miles per hour the speed limit on U.S. Highway 83 beginning at the South Dakota/Nebraska border, then north for 1.46 miles. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL §§ 32-25-7 and 32-25-7.1.

A public hearing will be held in the Commission Room, Becker Hansen Building, 700 East Broadway Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on November 29, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. CT.
