NOTICE:

The **Department of Social Services** intends to make the following changes to the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan concerning cost sharing for individuals eligible under the Breast and Cervical Cancer Medical Program effective January 1, 2014, as required by federal rule. The proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) eliminates cost sharing for individuals eligible for Medicaid under the Breast and Cervical Cancer Medical Program as required by 42 CFR 447.56(a)(xi). The proposed amendment revises page 55 of Section 4.18 of the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan. The Department estimates there will be a federal fiscal impact of \$10,937.52 in Federal Fiscal Year 2014 and \$14,583.36 in Federal Fiscal Year 2015. The **Department of Social Services** intends to make the following changes to the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan concerning presumptive eligibility determinations by hospitals effective January 1, 2014, as required by federal rule. The proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) defines the presumptive eligibility period and the criteria for hospitals making presumptive eligibility determinations. This SPA is required by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) under 42 CFR 435.1110. The proposed amendment adds page S21 to the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan. The Department estimates

there will be no federal fiscal impact associated with this SPA.
