Letter of Intent Regarding Legislation Approved in the 2013 Session

Dear Secretary Schopp:

This Letter of Intent sets forth a particular view held by the Joint Committee on Appropriations in approving your appropriation in the 2013 Legislative Session. As such, it supplements that appropriation with a specific policy guideline as approved on March 25, 2013.

While the guideline does not have the direct force of statutory law, it rests solidly on a long-standing tradition of Legislative-Executive relationships in South Dakota and it will be used by the Joint Committee as one basis for the fiscal oversight of your agency and its continued funding.

The 2013 South Dakota Legislature passed an emergency special appropriation of one-time funding for \$200,000 for the postsecondary technical institutes and \$5,829,318 of one-time funding for school districts through HB 1137.

It is the intent of the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations that the \$200,000 of one-time money for the postsecondary technical institutes be distributed in FY2013 in the same manner in which the formula funds were distributed to the institutes for FY2013. Therefore, the Committee directs the Secretary of the Department of Education to distribute the funds based upon the funding formula per administrative rule 24:10:42:28 in effect for FY2013 to the postsecondary technical institutes.

It is the intent of the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations that the \$5,829,318 of one-time money for the school districts assist each school district proportionally, therefore the Committee directs the Secretary of the Department of Education to distribute the funds on a fall enrollment basis using the actual 2012 fall enrollment figures.

In addition, it is also expected that you will be prepared to address this guideline in your FY15 budget presentation to the Joint Committee next January.
