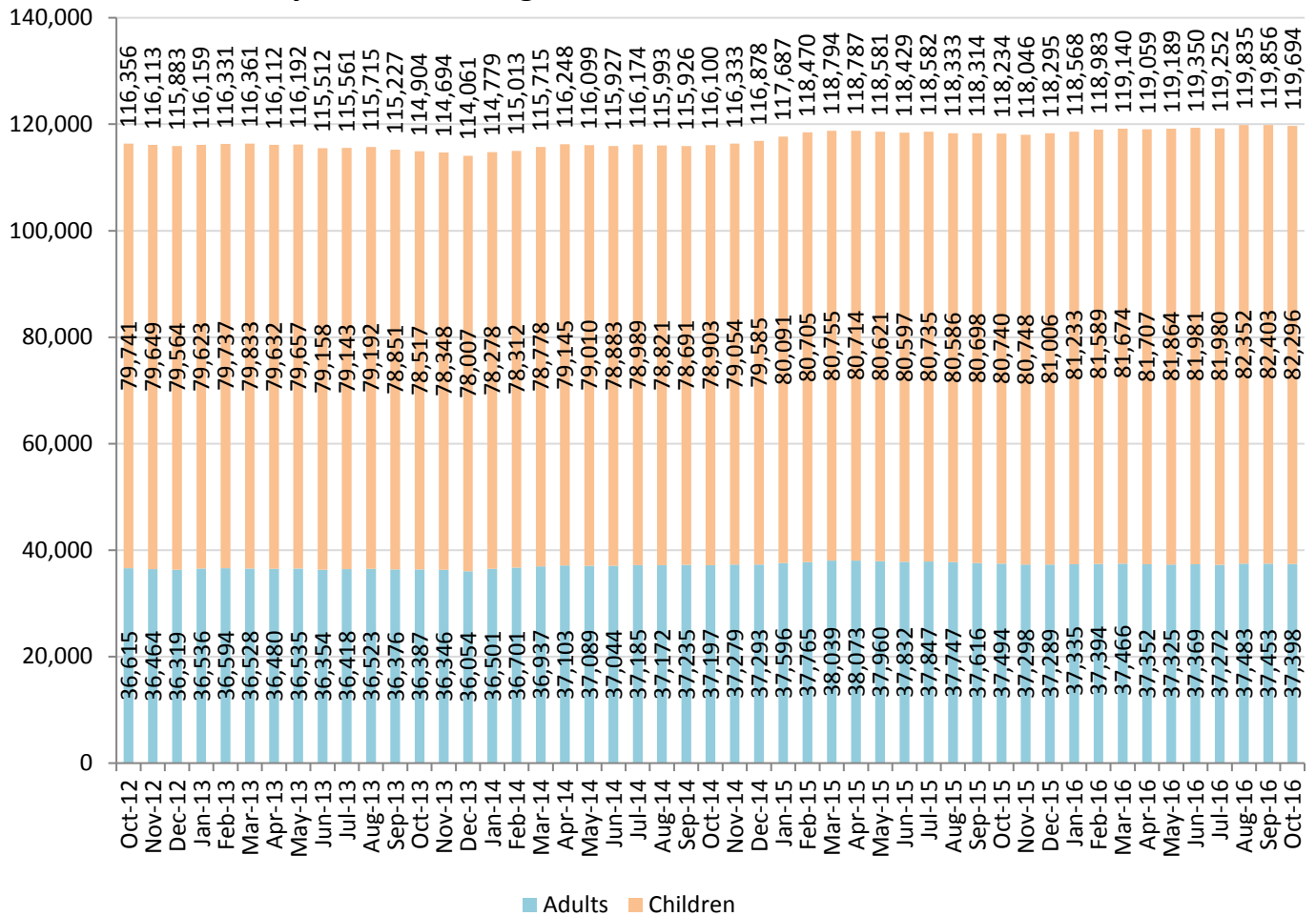
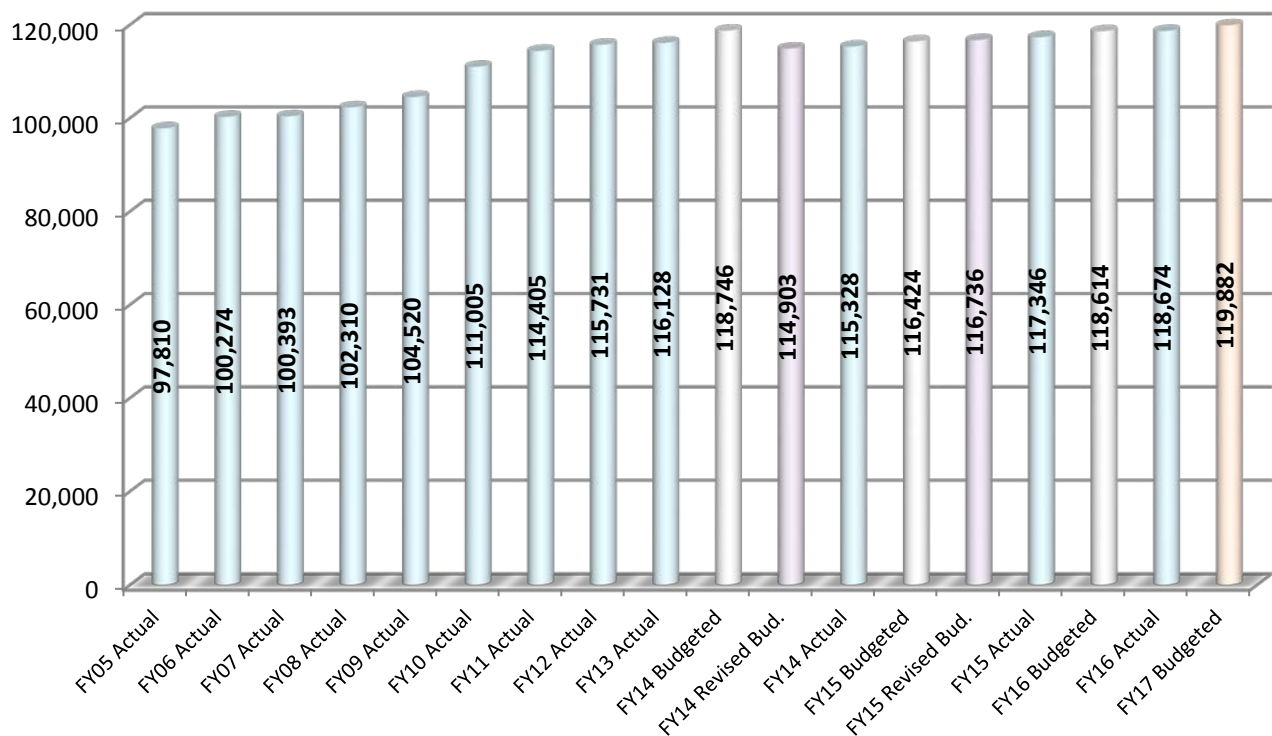

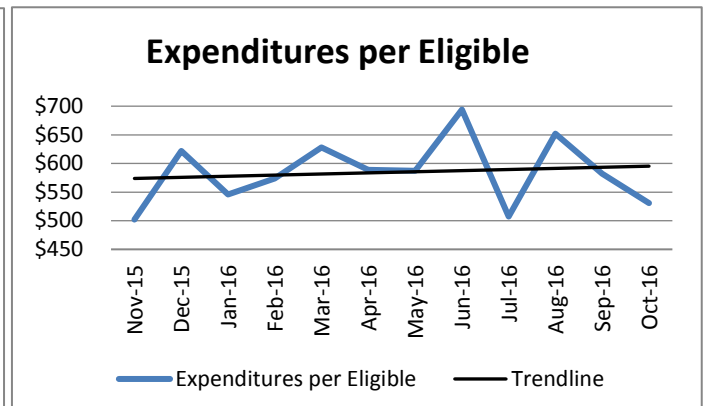

Part D payments are the State contribution for Prescription Drug Benefits for Medicaid Eligible Medicare Beneficiaries.

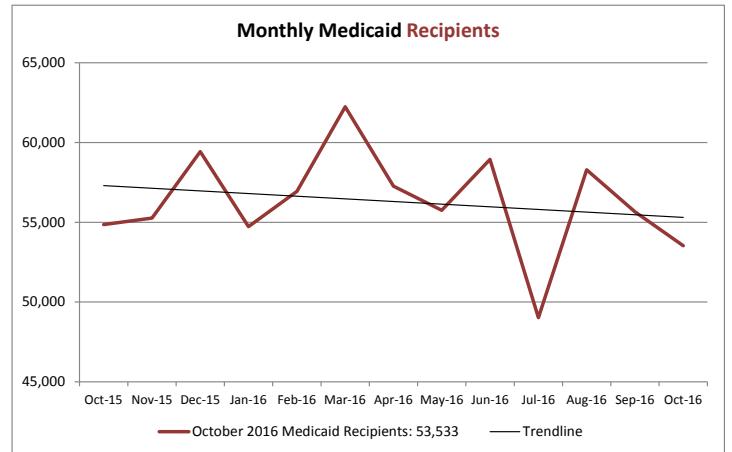
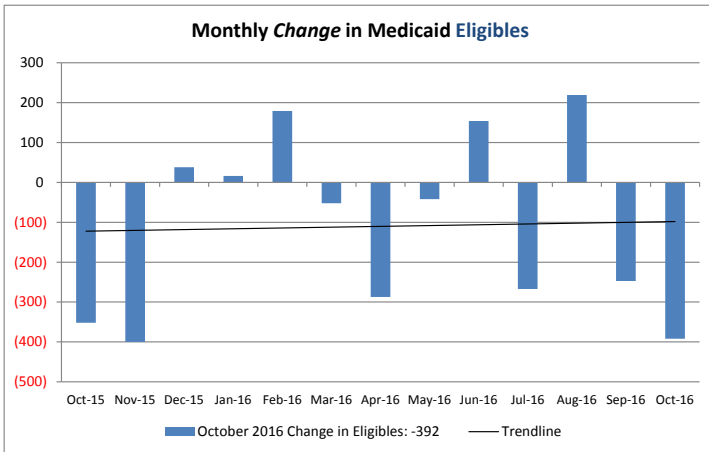
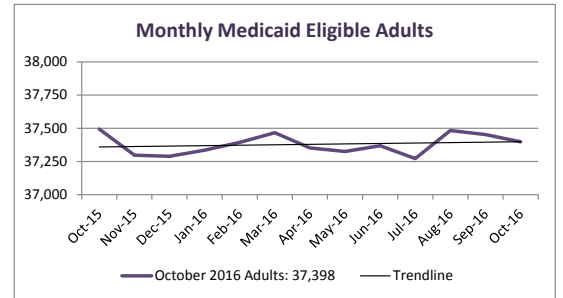
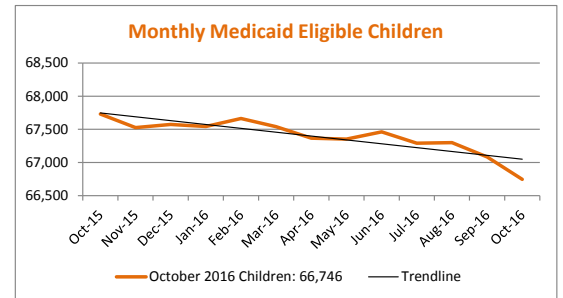
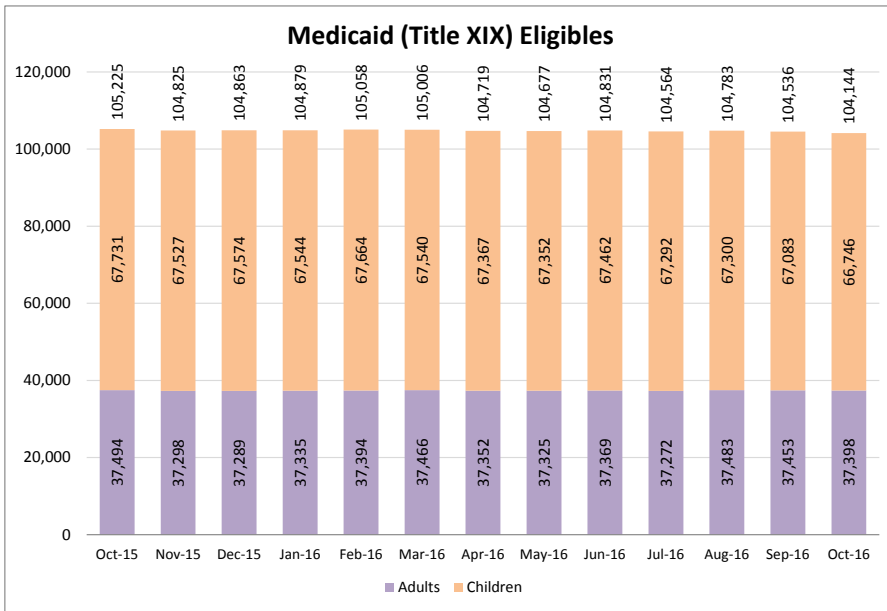
