

DIAL online classes are perfect to fit into any student's schedule. Students should spend time each day in their course but work can be done 24/7 and 7 days a week, if desired. Registration is done electronically by the school district through the SD Virtual School website. Our **CREDIT RECOVERY** classes provide an effective solution for students who need to recover credits to be on track for graduation. Courses are web-based and may be accessed from home, school, or wherever they can access a high speed internet connection. Students can progress at their own pace in order to master the material. Lesson level diagnostics allow students to move quickly through material they have previously mastered.

All of the credit recovery classes are also offered as **ORIGINAL CREDIT**.

Students can be registered at anytime for the DIAL online classes, even summer. Work on these classes can be done at a convenient time for the student as long as they have access to internet.

REMEDIAL COURSEWORK is also available for students in three areas: Elementary Algebra, Sentence Skills, and Reading Comprehension. Students with an ACT sub-score below 18 in English and below 20 in math are the target audience for the program. By successfully completing the program, students are able to save both time and money by avoiding zero credit remedial coursework at the start of their postsecondary career. Students may choose to complete their coursework in 10 weeks, 6 months, or 12 months. Costs range from \$125-\$175 depending on the time frame selected. Starting July 1, 2013, qualified students will be reimbursed the cost of the coursework if they complete within the registered timeframe. Gap year students may also participate in the program, but they should contact the course provider directly to register for the program

Starting June 1, 2013, DIAL will be running a pilot program that offers **COLLEGE CREDIT COURSES** available to high school students. Courses will be offered in the following areas:

Business	English	Math

The cost will be \$100/credit hour, plus books. Students will receive ACE credit, which can be transferred to our SD BOR institutions for a \$40 fee. Dual credit may also be given at the discretion of the local school district.
