General Comments from the Project Team

(2015 Interim Project Team: Sue, Hilary, Kevin, Doug)

- We suggest the result to be an identifiable, universal logo/design that represents us.
 - Executive Branch often uses Blue and the script South Dakota (as well as the state seal).
 - UJS uses Brown and its own seal.
- Interim and session, as well as the website, business cards, etc. will get the new logo.
- Dome – staff input indicated that it would be preferred to include a form of the dome if possible.
- Design should work regardless of the position, i.e. Left, Right and Center, if possible.

Any logo selected would include the use of an accent design on Cover Pages, PowerPoint Presentations and the website. We suggest the accent to be the interlocking squares in the colors of the House and Senate Chambers.

Actions

Several iterations of over 20 initial mock-ups were culled to six. After asking for staff input and suggestions the group narrowed the designs to three.

Those three were shown to staff along with draft documents for each. Each staff member was given the opportunity to choose a favorite. Sixteen of 22 staff voted for their favorite.

Design #1 received 13 votes.

Design #2 received two votes.

Design #3 received one vote.

A full packet of designs and documents were presented to the Executive Board in October.




