In accordance with SB 143, which was enacted by the Legislature this year, the Legislative Planning Committee will implement a performance management review process. The purpose of the review process is to provide legislators with a consistent system to evaluate the efficiency and effectiveness of state agencies, and to provide the public with further government transparency and accountability.

The committee will review the performance management of each state agency every three years. After an agency is reviewed, it will submit annual reports to the committee highlighting the agency's performance measures that show progress toward the desired outcomes. The Legislative Planning Committee will then compile the individual annual reports for distribution to legislators and for publication on the LRC website.

To begin its work, the committee has established the following tentative schedule for the first three years of the process. The committee will meet on May 17th to begin to review agencies in Group A.
