


Diversion Fiscal Incentive

- Section 5 of Senate Bill 73 from the 2015 Legislature requires the Department of Corrections to develop and administer a program to incentivize and support county use of court-approved diversion programs.
- 25 counties received reimbursement through the incentive program—a total of \$242,500.00 was paid in first year of program.

Detention Cost Sharing Program

- Created as part of JJRI to assist counties with any increased costs related to detention utilization.
- FY 17 budget includes \$150,000
- 13 counties bed day counts for 2016 exceeded the three year average.
- 66% of counties saw no increase
