Bill Drafting Process needs to:

- ✓ Provide greater accuracy in bills—stylistically and substantively
- ✓ Efficient—all of the necessary steps in the least amount of time
- ✓ Every step adds value
- ✓ Accomplish exceptional service to Legislature
- ✓ Allow everyone to know all the pieces of the whole process
- ✓ Allow everyone to understand the timing issues/requirements

Bill Drafting System needs to be:

- ✓ Flexible
- ✓ Easy to use
- ✓ Easy to train
- ✓ Minimize human error
- ✓ Uniform in process
- ✓ Allow for greater visibility

➤ **Not Goals**

- Change for the sake of change
- Paperless for the sake of paperless

Categories of Potential Upgrades

1. LRC internal processes
2. Word Perfect → Microsoft Word/XML
3. Dashboard/single sign-in
4. Interactivity through dashboard

For legislator consideration and authorization:

1. Electronic Authorizations (eliminate various forms; would require sign-in)
 1. Bill co-sponsorships*
 2. Prison/Jail Cost Estimates
 3. Fiscal Notes
 4. Constituents/Lobbyists to be contacted
2. Electronic bill/research requests
3. Chair authorizations*
4. Electronic assignments of bills by presiding officers to committee*
5. Electronic bill introductions*

*requires universal legislative implementation
