



Intern Recruitment Update – 2020 Legislative Session

Amanda Marsh and Sakura Rohleder are the intern coordinators for the 2020 Legislative Session and replace Emily Kerr.

This year's application deadline is Friday, October 11, 2019. Applications are live on the LRC website and can be found at <https://sdlegislature.gov/Students/Intern/Default.aspx>.

Campus visits are scheduled for SDSU, BHSU and USD in September.

Interviews will begin in late September and continue through late October. LRC will provide intern rankings by October 27 to leadership. The LRC intern coordinators will review and rank applicants and provide the leadership of each party with intern rankings and applicant materials (including transcripts and references).

Leadership will instruct LRC which applicants will receive internship offers. Intern candidates are often receiving competing offers at this point in the semester, so the earlier offers improve the chances of the highest ranked candidates accepting.

LRC intern coordinators will notify intern applicants immediately after leadership decisions. In the past, LRC has notified intern applicants of an internship offer between November 1-3. After the confirmation of applicants accepting the internship offer, leadership determines intern chamber assignments.

Intern orientation is scheduled for Monday, January 13, 2020.
