Acute and Geriatrics Program Information**

Adult Acute Program

- Program provides for initial assessment and stabilization of adult psychiatric patients
- 68 licensed beds that are certified by CMS for Medicare and Medicaid reimbursement
- Two units are closed due to direct care staffing shortages (current available beds: 38)

Geriatrics Program

- The Geriatrics Program provides skilled nursing care for patients who cannot be served in a community nursing home
- 69 licensed beds that are certified by CMS for Medicare and Medicaid reimbursement

Diagnostic Snapshot

On 10-15-18, of the 63 patients on the Geriatric units, 31.7% have some type of mental illness diagnosis while 68.3% do not.

14% have a serious mental illness.

62% have a primary diagnosis of dementia, Alzheimer's, or other neurocognitive disorder.
