1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the South Dakota Building Authority to
2 provide for the construction of a college of veterinary medicine and to make an
3 appropriation therefor.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. It is in the public interest that the South Dakota Building Authority contract for
6 the construction, completion, equipping, including heating, air conditioning, plumbing, water,
7 sewer, electric facilities, sidewalks, parking, landscaping, architectural and engineering services,
8 asbestos abatement, removal of existing roofing and structures, and such other services or
9 actions as may be required to establish a college of veterinary medicine on the campus of the
10 South Dakota State University in Brookings, South Dakota, at the estimated cost of thirty
11 million dollars. The South Dakota Building Authority may finance up to thirty million dollars
12 of the construction costs through the issuance of revenue bonds, in accordance with this Act and
13 chapter 5-12.



1 Section 2. The authorization granted by this Act and all necessary appropriations required
2 to finance and to complete the project remain effective through June 30, 2016.

3 Section 3. No indebtedness, bond, or obligation incurred or created under the authority of
4 this Act may be or may become a lien, charge, or liability against the State of South Dakota, nor
5 against the property or funds of the State of South Dakota within the meaning of the
6 Constitution or statutes of the state.

7 Section 4. The design and construction of the project authorized in this Act shall be under
8 the general supervision of the Bureau of Administration as provided in chapter 5-14. The
9 executive director of the Board of Regents and the executive secretary of the Building Authority
10 shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized
11 by this Act.

12 Section 5. The Board of Regents may make and enter into a lease agreement with the
13 Building Authority and make rental payments under the terms thereof, pursuant to chapter 5-12,
14 for the purposes of this Act.

15 Section 6. Rental payments under the terms of the lease authorized in section 5 of this Act
16 shall be paid from appropriations to be made by the Legislature for the payment of such rent to
17 support the purpose and the payment of bonds issued to cover up to thirty million dollars of
18 construction costs authorized in section 1 of this Act.
