1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit certain interaction between children and
2 registered sex offenders at youth activities.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 22-24B be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 No person who is required to register as a sex offender pursuant to chapter 22-24B may
7 teach, coach, supervise, monitor, oversee, proctor, or mentor any child under the age of sixteen
8 in conjunction with any meeting, class, sports event, or activity established or organized as
9 youth participation programs, groups, or associations. A violation of this section is a Class 1
10 misdemeanor.
