1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the certain provisions concerning continuing liens
2 on wages by garnishment.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 21-18-14.1 be amended to read as follows:

5 21-18-14.1. Notwithstanding the provisions of § 21-18-14, the plaintiff may obtain a
6 ~~sixty-day~~ ninety-day continuing lien on wages by garnishment. If a lien is to be obtained, the
7 plaintiff shall mark on the caption of the garnishee summons "continuing lien" and all disclosure
8 forms shall include the following:

9 Garnishee will continue to hold the nonexempt portion of the defendant's earnings as they
10 accrue through the last payroll period ending on or before ~~sixty~~ ninety days from the effective
11 date of the garnishee summons, or until the sum held equals the amount stated in the garnishee
12 summons, or until the employment relationship terminates, whichever first occurs.

13 At the time of the expected termination of the lien, the plaintiff shall mail to garnishee an
14 additional copy of the disclosure form upon which the garnishee within ten days shall make



1 further disclosure.
