SENATE BILL NO. 40

Introduced by: The Committee on Health and Human Services at the request of the Board of Dentistry

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for the suspension of certain licenses and
2 registrations relating to dentistry for failure to renew the license or registration.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 36-6A-52 be amended to read as follows:

5 36-6A-52. As a condition of annual renewal of a license, each licensee shall, on or before
6 the first day of July each year, transmit to the secretary-treasurer of the Board of Dentistry, upon
7 a form prescribed by the board, information as determined by rule, reasonably related to the
8 administration of a licensure system in the interest of public health and safety, together with the
9 fee established by the board, ~~and, in default of providing information or payment of the fee, the~~
10 ~~board may, in compliance with chapter 1-26, suspend the license of the dentist or dental~~
11 ~~hygienist during default, but the providing of information as requested by the board and the~~
12 ~~payment of the fee on or before the date of hearing, with an additional sum equal to that of the~~
13 ~~renewal fee, shall excuse the default and the suspension proceeding shall thereupon terminate.~~
14 The board may collect the fee by civil action. Failure of a licensee to renew a license on or
15 before the first day of July constitutes a suspension of the license by the licensee. At least thirty



1 days before July first, the board shall cause a written notice stating the amount and due date of
2 the fee and the information to be provided by the licensee, to be sent to ~~every licensed dentist~~
3 ~~and dental hygienist. Practitioners~~ each licensee. Each licensee shall report the information as
4 a condition of licensure renewal, except a change in home or office address shall be reported in
5 accordance with § 36-6A-58.

6 Section 2. That § 36-6A-53 be amended to read as follows:

7 36-6A-53. As a condition of annual renewal of a registration, each registrant shall, on or
8 before the first day of July, transmit to the secretary-treasurer of the Board of Dentistry, upon
9 a form prescribed by the board, information reasonably related to the administration of a
10 registration system in the interest of public health and safety, together with the fee established
11 by the board, ~~and, in default of providing information or payment of fee, the board may, in~~
12 ~~compliance with chapter 1-26, suspend the registration of the radiographer during default, but~~
13 ~~the providing of information as requested and the payment of the fee on or before the date of~~
14 ~~hearing shall excuse the default and the suspension proceeding shall thereupon terminate. The~~
15 ~~board may collect the fee by civil action. Failure of a registrant to renew a registration on or~~
16 before the first day of July constitutes a suspension of the registration held by the registrant. At
17 least thirty days before the first day of July, the board shall cause a written notice stating the
18 amount and due date of the fee and the information to be provided by the registrant to be sent
19 to ~~every registered radiographer. Radiographers~~ each registrant. Each registrant shall report the
20 information as a condition of registration renewal, except change in home or office address shall
21 be reported in accordance with § 36-6A-58.
