WHEREAS, Logan made history by winning six state wrestling championships in his weight class, including the Class B Championship in the 171 pound weight class for 2011; and

WHEREAS, Logan's other state championships included the 103 pound weight class in 2006, the 119 pound weight class in 2007, the 152 pound weight class in 2008, and the 171 pound weight class in 2010; and

WHEREAS, Logan became just the second wrestler in South Dakota history to win six state titles, with an amazing record of two hundred sixty-two wins and three losses:
