1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain requirements relating to participation by
2 tribal schools in the federal school lunch program.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-35-1 be amended to read as follows:

5 13-35-1. School districts and other agencies eligible under Title 42 United States Code
6 §§ 1751 to 1769, inclusive, and §§ 1771 to 1785, inclusive, the National School Lunch Act and
7 the Child Nutrition Act of 1966, may enter into contractual agreements with the Department of
8 Education for the purpose of establishing school food services programs. The agreements and
9 the operation of such programs are subject to the provisions of this chapter and the rules for
10 school food services programs as adopted by the South Dakota Board of Education. A tribal
11 school operated in conjunction with a federally-recognized Indian tribe or a school operated by
12 the federal Bureau of Indian Education need not be accredited by the State of South Dakota in
13 order to enter into an agreement under this section if the school is accredited by a regional or



1 national school accreditation agency.
