[HB 1027](#) revise the definition of a trailer for the purpose of titling a restored or rebuilt trailer.

- [SB 52](#) (Deferred from 17th LD)authorize the South Dakota Building Authority and the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs to provide for the design, construction, and equipping of the veterans home near Hot Springs and to declare an emergency.
- [SB 72*](#) (Deferred from 17th LD)revise how certain kindergarten students are counted for the purpose of state aid to education funding, to establish in statute the minimum number of hours required in a school term for grades one through three, and to provide for the redistribution of certain funds appropriated for state aid to education.
- [SB 97*](#) (Deferred from 17th LD)revise the membership of certain local boards of equalization.
- [SB 51*](#) revise certain provisions relating to a previous appropriation for renovation of the nursing care building on the South Dakota Veterans' Home campus and to declare an emergency.
- [SB 65*](#) allow nonpublic schools accredited by certain accrediting agencies other than the Department of Education to become members of the South Dakota High School Activities Association.
- [SB 68](#) authorize investment of certain public funds in bonds issued by political subdivisions or agencies of the state.
- [SB 95](#) provide for the printing of voting rights notices.
- [SB 101*](#) provide a penalty for denying access to public records.
- [SB 146](#) require certain notice requirements for retailers that do not have nexus in South Dakota which are selling tangible personal property, services, or products transferred electronically for use in South Dakota.
- [SB 147](#) expand the application of nexus for the purpose of collecting sales and use taxes owed to the state.
