- HCR 1007 (HJ 16<sup>th</sup> LD) Urging the members of the South Dakota Congressional delegation to sponsor and support the Marketplace Fairness Act and the Marketplace Equity Act.
- SCR 2 (SJ 258) Urging the United States Postal Service to reconsider the closing of post offices in rural South Dakota.
- HB 1158 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by which Passed) allow students attending nonpublic high schools to be eligible for the jump start scholarship program.
