1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish a classroom innovation grant program and to
2 make an appropriation therefor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby established in the Department of Education a classroom
5 innovation grant program. The purpose of the grant program is to provide funding for
6 classroom innovation to allow classroom teachers to utilize technology in creative and
7 innovative ways to enhance the learning and achievement of their students. Applications for the
8 innovation grants may be submitted by individual teachers, school districts, or education service
9 agencies established pursuant to § 13-3-76.

10 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of five hundred
11 thousand dollars (\$500,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of
12 Education for distribution through the classroom innovation grant program established in this
13 Act.



1 Section 3. The secretary of education shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw
2 warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

3 Section 4. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
4 June 30, 2015, shall revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
