- [SB 23](#)* (Deferred from the 23rd LD) revise certain provisions pertaining to the Certification Board for Alcohol and Drug Professionals and to increase certain fees.
- [SB 72](#)* (Deferred from the 23rd LD) revise certain provisions concerning inspections of food service establishments by the Department of Health.
- [SB 18](#)* (Deferred from the 23rd LD) authorize the Department of Agriculture to construct a 4-H exhibit hall in Huron and to make an appropriation therefor.
