- [SB 85](#) (Deferred from 12th LD) revise certain provisions regarding the production incentive payment available to ethanol producers.
- [SB 16](#) (Deferred from 12th LD) authorize the Brand Board to establish a service fee for certain local inspections of livestock and to declare an emergency.
- [SB 21](#) (Deferred from 12th LD) eliminate ownership inspection for horses and mules.
- [SB 76*](#) appropriate money to fund the education service agencies.
- [SB 18*](#) authorize the Department of Agriculture to construct a 4-H exhibit hall in Huron and to make an appropriation therefor.
- [SB 19*](#) authorize the Department of Agriculture to construct a housing unit in Huron, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
