[SB 159](#) (Deferred from 19th LD) revise the state aid to general education formula by including an adjustment for students with limited English proficiency.

[SB 215](#) (Deferred from 21st LD) provide procedures by which adopted persons may obtain their original birth certificates.

- [SJR 1](#) (Deferred 21st LD) Proposing and submitting to the electors at the next general election an amendment to Article III, section 6 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to legislative terms and legislative term limits.
- [SB 166](#) (Deferred from 21st LD) revise the number of years that permits to carry a concealed weapon are valid.
- [SB 207](#) (Deferred from 21st LD) make certain legislative findings concerning federal infringement on Second Amendment rights.

- [SB 151*](#) (Deferred from 21st LD) clarify the maintenance responsibilities on unimproved section lines.

- [SB 138](#) (Deferred from 21st LD) revise certain provisions regarding educational data reporting.
- [SB 10](#) (Deferred from 21st LD) authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the construction of swine teaching and research facilities at South Dakota State University and to make an appropriation therefor.
- [SB 11](#) (Deferred from 21st LD) authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the construction of an indoor practice and human performance facility on the campus of South Dakota State University and to make an appropriation therefor.
- [SB 189](#) (Deferred from 21st LD) make appropriations from the water and environment fund, the water pollution control revolving fund subfund, and the drinking water revolving fund subfund for various water and environmental purposes and to declare an emergency.
- [SB 111](#) (Deferred from 21st LD) amend provisions of the Uniform Commercial Code relating to electronic funds transfers and to declare an emergency.
- [SB 190*](#) make an appropriation to fund tax refunds for elderly persons and persons with a disability, to revise the income eligibility requirements for property and sales tax refunds, and to declare an emergency.
- [SB 194](#) extend the sunset date for certain expenditures from a school district's capital outlay fund.
