[SB 199*](#) exempt all property used for educational purposes from taxation:
Exempt certain property used for educational purposes from taxation.

- [SB 206](#) revise certain provisions relating to liability and to worker's compensation and disability payments for law enforcement officers performing duties in other jurisdictions.
- [HB 1034](#) revise certain provisions regarding the procedure for setting petroleum examination and testing specifications and methods.

- [SB 114](#) provide a definition of smoking.
- [SB 238](#) appropriate money to the animal damage control fund for predator control services and to declare an emergency.

- [HB 1019](#) (Deferred from 23rd LD) authorize the involuntary treatment of jailed prisoners with psychotropic medication.
- [HB 1020*](#) (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise certain provisions relating to the evaluation and treatment of persons with mental illness.
- [HB 1091*](#) (Deferred from 23rd LD) establish certain provisions regarding the labeling of motor fuel at a retail fuel pump.
- [HB 1011](#) (Deferred from 23rd LD) authorize the Board of Hearing Aid Dispensers and Audiologists to establish a thirty day trial period for the sale of hearing aids.
- [HB 1071](#) (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise the contents of the application for the discharge of a civil judgment debt discharged in bankruptcy.
- [HB 1072](#) (Deferred from 23rd LD) repeal certain provisions providing a criminal penalty for a political party to endorse or nominate a judicial candidate.
- [HB 1073*](#) (Deferred from 23rd LD) establish a procedure for the determination of the competency of a juvenile to proceed in a juvenile court matter.
- [HB 1074*](#) (Deferred from 23rd LD) define the insurer's responsibilities concerning health insurance policies in relation to the eligibility of minor dependents for coverage.
- [HB 1125](#) (Deferred from 23rd LD) allow perpetual care and maintenance guarantee funds for cemeteries to be administered by cemetery corporations.
- [HB 1127](#) (Deferred from 23rd LD) provide for certain use of income and principal from a perpetual care and maintenance guarantee fund for cemeteries.
- [HB 1070*](#) (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise certain provisions relating to the failure to fulfill the responsibilities of jury duty.
