1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the South Dakota Building Authority to finance  
2 the construction of improvements in the state park system for the Department of Game, Fish  
3 and Parks and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. It is in the public interest that the South Dakota Building Authority contract for  
6 the construction of a visitor center and associated interpretive displays at Good Earth State Park  
7 at Blood Run, including engineering and bonding services, site preparation, and construction  
8 of improvements. The Building Authority may finance this project, including the issuance of  
9 revenue bonds not to exceed two million dollars (\$2,000,000), in accordance with this Act and  
10 chapter 5-12.

11 Section 2. It is in the public interest that the South Dakota Building Authority contract for  
12 the construction of a visitor center at Custer State Park, including engineering and bonding  
13 services, site preparation, and construction of improvements. The Building Authority may  
14 finance this project, including the issuance of revenue bonds not to exceed one million dollars



1 (\$1,000,000), in accordance with this Act and chapter 5-12.

2 Section 3. No indebtedness, bond, or obligation incurred or created under authority of this  
3 Act may be or may become a lien, charge, or liability against the State of South Dakota, nor  
4 against the property or funds of the State of South Dakota within the meaning of the  
5 Constitution or statutes of South Dakota.

6 Section 4. The Building Authority may accept and expend in addition to the amount  
7 specified in sections 1 and 2 of this Act for the purpose stated in these sections, any funds  
8 obtained from gifts, contributions, or other sources for the purpose.

9 Section 5. The design and construction of improvements shall be under the general charge  
10 and supervision of the Bureau of Administration as provided in § 5-14-2. The Bureau of  
11 Administration and the Department of Game, Fish and Parks shall approve vouchers and the  
12 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenses authorized by this Act.

13 Section 6. The Department of Game, Fish and Parks may make and enter into a lease  
14 agreement with the Building Authority and make rental payments under the terms of the  
15 agreement for the purposes of this Act, pursuant to chapter 5-12, from fund appropriations or  
16 from gifts, contributions, or other sources.

17 Section 7. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its  
18 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in  
19 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
