1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require that the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the
2 United States be recited at the start of each school day in every public school classroom.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-24-17.2 be amended to read as follows:

5 13-24-17.2. The right to post the United States flag shall not be limited or infringed upon
6 in any public school classroom, public school building, at any public school event, or on any
7 public school uniform. ~~The right to recite~~ Each school district shall provide students the
8 opportunity to salute the United States and the flag each day by reciting the pledge of allegiance
9 to the flag of the United States ~~shall not be limited or infringed upon, and the.~~ A student may
10 choose not to participate in the salute to the United States and the flag. However, a student who
11 does not participate in the salute shall maintain a respectful silence during the salute. The
12 national anthem may be sung during any school day or school event.
