1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the increase in the number of video lottery
2 machines that may placed in a licensed establishment under certain conditions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 42-7A-44 be amended to read as follows:

5 42-7A-44. The placement of video lottery machines in licensed establishments including the
6 number of machines, not to exceed fifteen machines per establishment, shall be subject to the
7 rules of the commission promulgated pursuant to chapter 1-26. ~~No more than ten video lottery~~
8 ~~machines may be placed in any licensed establishment.~~ If more than ten video lottery machines
9 are placed in a licensed establishment, the number of video lottery machines that run the South
10 Dakota video lottery terminal communication protocol revision C & D may not exceed the
11 number of machines that used the protocol in the establishment on July 1, 2014. The bar or
12 lounge with an on-sale license issued pursuant to subdivision 35-4-2(12) or (16) shall be
13 restricted to persons twenty-one years of age or older. The entrance to the area where video
14 lottery machines are located shall display a sign that the premises are restricted to persons



1 twenty-one years or older. Notwithstanding the restrictions in §§ 35-4-79 to 35-4-79.2,
2 inclusive, persons under the age of twenty-one may only enter the premises where video lottery
3 machines are located provided they are accompanied by a parent, guardian, or spouse of
4 twenty-one years or older.
