## SENATE BILL NO. 69

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to define that certain wages earned may not be used for  
2 calculating the contributions to the state unemployment compensation fund.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 61-5 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as  
5 follows:

6 If any person, who owns a portion or all of a business, is not eligible to receive  
7 unemployment compensation benefits pursuant to this title for wages earned by that person at  
8 such business or employer, the employer may not be required to include that person's wages  
9 when calculating the employer's contribution to the state unemployment compensation fund.
