- HB 1046 (Deferred from 8th LD) revise certain provisions regarding licenses issued by the State Plumbing Commission and the fees that may be set by the commission.
- HB 1036 (Deferred from 8th LD) revise certain provisions regarding the billboard permitting process.
- HB 1013* (Deferred from 8th LD) authorize the South Dakota Building Authority to finance the construction of improvements in the state park system for the Department of Game, Fish and Parks and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1057 (Deferred from 8th LD) repeal certain provisions imposing the inheritance tax and the estate tax.
- HB 1060* revise certain provisions regarding military speciality plates.
- HB 1070 sunset certain tax refund claims for an economic development incentive program that has been previously terminated and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1030 provide for the confidentiality of certain evaluation data.
- HB 1049 establish and revise certain provisions regarding the South Dakota Athletic Commission.
- HB 1022 authorize the Board of Regents to purchase improved property in Spearfish and to make an appropriation therefor.
- HB 1039 revise certain reversion provisions relating to the General Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2013.
- HB 1041 make an appropriation for the railroad trust fund and to declare an emergency.
