MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

HCR 1010 (HJ 12th LD) Requesting the Committee on Government Operations and Audit to conduct hearings relating to the operations of the Governor's Office of Economic Development.

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

HB 1068* revise provisions relating to the use of dogs in hunting mountain lions.
HB 1076* revise certain requirements relating to party fishing.
HB 1080 clarify that emergency personnel driving records are not to include motor vehicle accidents resulting while engaged in the performance of their official duties.
HB 1118 clarify certain provisions about discharging firearms in safety zones.
HB 1119 revise certain provisions relating to preliminary hearings for persons charged with class 1 misdemeanors.

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1019* (Deferred from 12 LD) provide certain provisions regarding the requirements for postsecondary institutions to participate in a multistate state authorization reciprocity agreement for distance education activities.
HB 1081 (Deferred from 12th LD) revise the computation of the promotional fee on wheat.

- HB 1094 (Deferred from 12th LD) prohibit a person from interfering with a public safety answering point.
- HB 1058 (Deferred from 12th LD) revise certain provisions concerning the application of railroad tax credits.
- HB 1087 (Deferred from 12th LD) change how rural fire protection districts conduct elections.
- HB 1092* require that crematories be under the direction of licensed funeral establishments and funeral directors.
- HB 1069* revise the maximum redemption fee for property tax deeds.
- HB 1086* create a leased residential property classification and to establish the school district general fund levy for the property classification.
- HB 1074* revise certain provisions concerning actions prohibited near polling places.
- HB 1084 revise certain provisions regarding the list of persons who may be excluded from a licensed gaming establishment and to provide a penalty for a violation of the exclusion.
- HB 1099 revise the membership of the State Investment Council.
- HJR 1002 Proposing and submitting to the electors at the next general election an amendment to Article III, section 6 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to legislative term limits.
- HB 1104 allow local governing bodies to require the payment for certain goods and services by electronic transaction.
- HB 1108 repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions regarding employment strikes and lockouts.
- HB 1111 revise certain provisions related to the design, construction, and equipping of a veterans home near Hot Springs, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1113 make an appropriation to fund tax refunds for elderly persons and persons with a disability and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1100 prohibit the use of certain photo radar speed detection systems and of certain photo monitoring devices to detect red light violations.
