MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HCR 1017 (HJ 16<sup>th</sup> LD; Deferred from 17<sup>th</sup> LD) Urging Congress, the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP), the United States Department of Justice, and the United States Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) to recognize industrial hemp as a valuable agricultural commodity.
- HCR 1012 (HJ 14<sup>th</sup> LD) Recognizing the honor and remember flag as the designated symbol of South Dakota's concern and commitment to honoring and remembering all members of the United States Armed Forces who have lost their lives while serving, or as a result of service, and their families.
- HCR 1018 (HJ 19<sup>th</sup> LD) Recognizing Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) as a serious and chronic disease in South Dakota.
- HCR 1019 (HJ 19<sup>th</sup> LD) Petitioning Congress to reauthorize federally provided terrorism reinsurance for insurers.

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1157\* provide for the retrospective payment of clean claims for covered services provided by a health care professional during the credentialing period.

- HB 1097\* revise the criteria for classifying property as agricultural land.
- HB 1140\* permit townships to levy a capital improvement property tax for secondary roads, bridges, and culverts.
- HB 1213\* analyze and promote economic development for South Dakota's Native American population and to establish a task force.
- HB 1221\* exempt certain amateur sports coaches from sales and use tax.
- HB 1132 make a minor's school calendar the reference point from which to permit employment that would not interfere with the minor's education.
- HB 1122 (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) prohibit the collection in South Dakota of civil fines arising from speeding or red light cameras in other states.
- HB 1171 (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) revise provisions relating to trespass associated with hunting, fishing, or trapping.
- HB 1111 (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) revise certain provisions related to the design, construction, and equipping of a veterans home near Hot Springs, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.

## SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 12 (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) update references to certain federal motor carrier regulations.
- SB 64 (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) require a waiting period prior to the adoption of new uniform content standards and to provide for an opportunity for public comment for all new content standards.
- SB 55 (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) repeal the contractor's excise tax on certain new or expanded power production facilities.
- SB 27 (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation from the coordinated natural resources conservation fund to the State Conservation Commission and to declare an emergency.
- SB 31 (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation to reimburse certain family physicians who have complied with the requirements of the recruitment assistance program and to declare an emergency.
- SB 32 (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) revise previous appropriations for National Guard armory construction, to make an appropriation for a land purchase adjacent to the Watertown armory, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 63\* (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) protect the privacy of the records of individual students.
- SB 14 (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) revise certain provisions pertaining to the Board of Examiners of Counselors and Marriage and Family Therapists.
