SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1122 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) prohibit the collection in South Dakota of civil fines arising from speeding or red light cameras in other states.  
HB 1171 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) revise provisions relating to trespass associated with hunting, fishing, or trapping.  
HB 1121\* (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) include certain actions in liens on property sold for tax deed.

- HB 1204\* (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) include certain funds in a school district's local effort for purposes of the state aid to general education formula.
- HB 1043\* revise and repeal certain provisions regarding the regulation of aeronautics.
- HB 1150 require that the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States be recited at the start of each school day in every public school classroom.
- HB 1229 provide for the reporting of certain person's names to the National Instant Criminal Background Check System.
- HB 1111 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) revise certain provisions related to the design, construction, and equipping of a veterans home near Hot Springs, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.

## SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 12 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) update references to certain federal motor carrier regulations.
- SB 64 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) require a waiting period prior to the adoption of new uniform content standards and to provide for an opportunity for public comment for all new content standards.
- SB 55 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) repeal the contractor's excise tax on certain new or expanded power production facilities.
- SB 27 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) make an appropriation from the coordinated natural resources conservation fund to the State Conservation Commission and to declare an emergency.
- SB 31 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) make an appropriation to reimburse certain family physicians who have complied with the requirements of the recruitment assistance program and to declare an emergency.
- SB 32 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) revise previous appropriations for National Guard armory construction, to make an appropriation for a land purchase adjacent to the Watertown armory, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 63\* (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) protect the privacy of the records of individual students.
- SB 14 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) revise certain provisions pertaining to the Board of Examiners of Counselors and Marriage and Family Therapists.
- SB 89 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions regarding the medical department of the National Guard.
- SB 93 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) define liquid natural gas, to revise certain provisions regarding the collection of the motor fuel tax, and to apply motor fuel tax to all fuels used to propel a motor vehicle.
- SB 103\* (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) establish certain civil penalties for tampering or removing any highway marker, sign, or control device and to distribute the revenue from such civil penalties.
- SB 29\* revise certain provisions in statute and administrative rules regarding the regulation of campgrounds and the license fee for campgrounds and to repeal administrative rules regulating primitive campgrounds, full-service campgrounds, limited service campgrounds, and temporary campgrounds.
