SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 119 update and revise the statutes relating to the South Dakota Board on Geographic Names.
- SB 39 revise certain provisions regarding the regulation of certain open containers of alcoholic beverages.
- SB 60 revise certain provisions regarding the titling and licensing of boats and motor vehicles and to establish certain penalties for violation of those provisions.
- SB 88 repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions regarding traction engines operated over bridges.

- HB 1134* (Removed from Consent Calendar) clarify certain municipal powers.
- HB 1142* enhance the support for public postsecondary technical institutes and to make an appropriation therefor.

- HB 1166* revise the telecommunications services program to include current and developing technology.
- HB 1129* prohibit the use of certain explosive targets in the Black Hills Forest Fire Protection District.
- HB 1085 revise certain property tax levies for the general fund of school districts.
- HB 1111 (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise certain provisions related to the design, construction, and equipping of a veterans home near Hot Springs, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 12 (Deferred from 23rd LD) update references to certain federal motor carrier regulations.
- SB 64 (Deferred from 23rd LD) require a waiting period prior to the adoption of new uniform content standards and to provide for an opportunity for public comment for all new content standards.
- SB 55 (Deferred from 23rd LD) repeal the contractor's excise tax on certain new or expanded power production facilities.
- SB 27 (Deferred from 23rd LD) make an appropriation from the coordinated natural resources conservation fund to the State Conservation Commission and to declare an emergency.
- SB 31 (Deferred from 23rd LD) make an appropriation to reimburse certain family physicians who have complied with the requirements of the recruitment assistance program and to declare an emergency.
- SB 32 (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise previous appropriations for National Guard armory construction, to make an appropriation for a land purchase adjacent to the Watertown armory, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 63* (Deferred from 23rd LD) protect the privacy of the records of individual students.
- SB 14 (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise certain provisions pertaining to the Board of Examiners of Counselors and Marriage and Family Therapists.
- SB 89 (Deferred from 23rd LD) repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions regarding the medical department of the National Guard.
- SB 93 (Deferred from 23rd LD) define liquid natural gas, to revise certain provisions regarding the collection of the motor fuel tax, and to apply motor fuel tax to all fuels used to propel a motor vehicle.
- SB 103* (Deferred from 23rd LD) establish certain civil penalties for tampering or removing any highway marker, sign, or control device and to distribute the revenue from such civil penalties.
- SB 29* (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise certain provisions in statute and administrative rules regarding the regulation of campgrounds and the license fee for campgrounds and to repeal administrative rules regulating primitive campgrounds, full-service campgrounds, limited service campgrounds, and temporary campgrounds.
- SB 54* revise the definition of a boat dealer, used vehicle dealer, and dealer of mobile homes or manufactured homes, and to revise certain penalties for selling motor vehicles, snowmobiles, mobile homes, manufactured homes, or boats without a license.
- SB 59 increase the penalty for the trafficking of vehicle license plates and decals, to prohibit and provide a penalty for the unauthorized transfer of a vehicle license plate or decal, and to impose a penalty for altering or forging certain vehicle registration cards.
